**ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF’S APPLICATION AND MOTION FOR
PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION**

Before the Court is Plaintiff National Urban League, Inc. (“NUL”)’s Application and Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunction (Doc. 8).

The Court, having conducted a hearing on December 2, 2015, and Plaintiff NUL having appeared through counsel, Patterson Belknap Webb & Tyler LLP and Munsch Hardt Kopf & Harr, P.C., and presented arguments in support of a preliminary injunction; and Defendants Urban League of Greater Dallas & North Central Texas, Inc. (“ULGD”) and Terry Woods (collectively, “Defendants”) having appeared through counsel, the King-Mays Firm, and presented argument in opposition to the Motion and Application; and the Court, having considered the papers filed by both NUL and Defendants ULGD and Woods; and based on the pleadings and proceedings held to date; and good cause having been shown,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED ON THIS 8th day of December 2015:


(1) Defendants ULGD and Terry Woods are hereby preliminarily enjoined from using in any manner the registered service marks owned by the NUL, specifically, the name “Urban League” and the equality symbol enclosed within a circle; and

(2) Defendants ULGD and Terry Woods are hereby preliminary enjoined from making any further representations, in any form or medium to any person or entity, that either ULGD or Terry Woods is affiliated or associated with NUL; and it is further

ORDERED that the NUL shall post bond in the amount of \$10,000 no later than January 15, 2016; and it is further

ORDERED that within thirty (30) days of being served with this Order, Defendants ULGD and Terry Woods shall file with the Court and serve on the Plaintiff a report, pursuant to Title 15, United States Code, Section 1116(a), that sets forth in writing and under oath the manner and form in which Defendants have complied with this preliminary injunction.
